Did you know?

In 2011 in South Dakota

- 1,353 children were victims of abuse or neglect
- 1,407 children resided in foster or kinship care, and were under the court's jurisdiction
- Most children are not allowed in court and do not have an advocate to speak for them in court.

United Way Partnerships:

- *Southeast CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocate) promotes and protects the best interest of abused and neglected children involved in the court system in Yankton County.*
- *In 2014, Southeast CASA served 25 local children in the court system who were the victims of child abuse and neglect, through the assistance of 13 CASA volunteers.*
- *Research shows that children with a CASA volunteer spend 7.5 months less in foster care, experience fewer out of home placements, and have significantly improved educational performance.*
